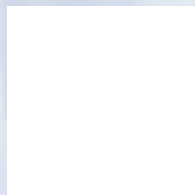

## Hospice Care

Hospice was created to support people when curative treatment for a life-limiting condition no longer applies and emphasizes quality of life rather than length of life.

**Providing the highest quality residential hospice to our area is our core mission at Omega House.**

We are a licensed foster care facility, staffed to provide superb resident experience. Envisioned to be like home, Omega House provides a better option when staying at home is not comfortable or appropriate.

Anyone in a homecare-hospice program or who could qualify medically is eligible.

We do not accept Medicare, Medicaid or third-party insurances. Daily rates may be discounted, based on resident's household income. Some residents may qualify for a period of free care, via the Gerald Vairo Memorial Fund. Eligible veterans will receive a discount.



## Respite Care

If you are caring for a loved one, you know it is rewarding, but it can also be emotionally and physically exhausting. At times you may need a break. Our Respite Care service provides that break, while ensuring a safe and comfortable environment for your loved one, for a few days to a few weeks.

Respite care also provides 24/7 support to individuals recuperating after surgery, illness or hospitalization who may not feel comfortable returning home from the hospital, or when caregivers are away.



## Volunteers

Our volunteers play an important role at Omega House. They become an integral part of our team—embracing our core values of compassion and humility.
